The undersigned organizations urge you to include resilience as a priority for the work of your committees in 2023.

We represent a broad group of leaders from business, conservation, environment, open space, and state and local government. Building smart, modern, resilient infrastructure has been among our top priorities. These suggestions would add value and improve the current recent successes in the resilience and predisaster policy space, from enactment of the Safeguarding Tomorrow through Ongoing Risk Mitigation Act and Community Disaster Resilience Zone Act to the resilience provisions of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

The following underscore several important issues for your consideration and support:

- Establishing a Chief Resilience Officer at the White House and calling for interagency coordination and development of a national resilience strategy.
- Increasing the portion of postdisaster funding directed for predisaster mitigation purposes, especially in FEMA's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Program.
- Promoting incentives, including tax credits for individuals and businesses for predisaster mitigation expenses.

We commend your strong support for predisater mitigation and its value for the American taxpayer with an estimated benefit-cost ratio of up to 6 to 1. Resilience is, simply put, good public policy for the environment and the economy.
