



# ARC-X Guiding Tool for ICWP membership



## What is ARC-X?

- ARC-X, also known as the Climate Change Adaptation Resource Center, is an interactive EPA resource that allows localized governments to gather tailored information related to climate change adaptation.
- Users can find information on the risks posed by various climate change concerns, relevant adaptation strategies, case studies from other communities addressing similar problems, and EPA funding opportunities included in the resource.
- With 8 regions and over 25 areas of interest (14 of which are water related), organizations can personalize their search down to the specifics.

## How can I use it?

Navigate to the ARC-X website (link provided) and click on the "Tailor your Search" link.

Select your desired region and areas of interest within the displayed search engine.

Browse 7 results tabs for applicable information, tools, and resources, including general adaptation info.
