The Threat and Hazard identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) is FEMA's three step risk assessment process that helps communities understand their risks and what they need to do to adress those risks by asking the following core questions...

Core Questions

- What threats and hazards can affect our community?
- If they occurred, what impacts would those threats and hazards have on our community?
- Based on those impacts, what capabilities should our community have?
