



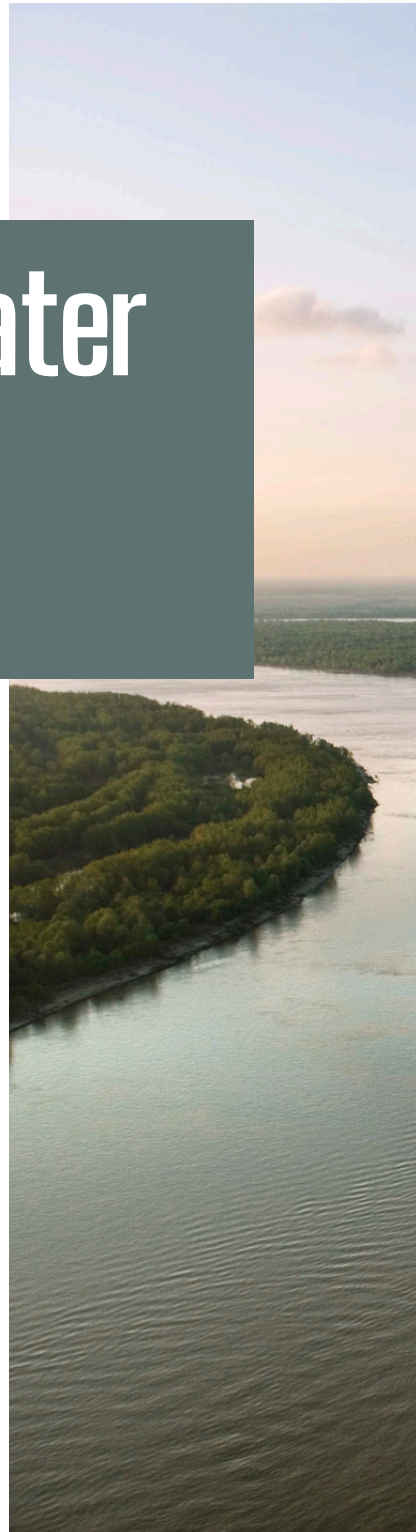
# Interstate Water Management Committee
